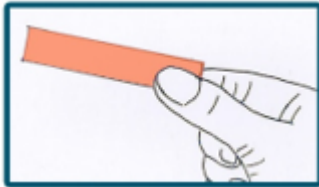


Ring Additional Size Guide

For **Ring** – Steps to Measure your Additional Size using a Long Strip of Paper and a Ruler



1) Use a wide strip of paper



2) Wrap it around the base of your finger



3) Mark the point where the end meet



4) Wrap the same paper around the second knuckle of your finger



5) Mark the point where the end meet around the Knuckle



6) Use a millimetre ruler and measure the strip of paper for the bigger measurement of the two

Length of Strip (Circumference in mm)	Ring Size
46.7	4
49.3	5
51.8	6
54.5	7
57.1	8
59.3	9
62.3	10
64.9	11
67.5	12
70.1	13
72.5	14
75.1	15
77.7	16

7) Use the chart above to find your Additional Ring size

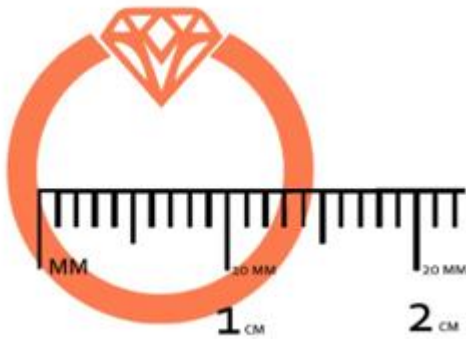
Note: Please ensure you use the Bigger Measurement of the two Measurements so as to make sure your Ring will slip in your finger comfortably



Ring Additional Size Guide

For **Ring** – Steps to Measure your Additional Size using an Existing Ring

- 1) Place the ring on a ruler
- 2) Measure the largest distance between the inner edges of your Ring



Existing Ring (Diameter in mm)	Ring Size
14.8	4
15.7	5
16.5	6
17.3	7
18.1	8
18.8	9
19.8	10
20.6	11
21.4	12
22.3	13
23.1	14
23.9	15
24.7	16

Note: If your Measurement Falls between two ring sizes, then choose the larger size so that your ring will slip comfortably

- 3) Use the chart above to find your Additional Ring size
